1. 100TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE DEATH OF ARCHBISHOP JOSEPH THOMAS DUHAMEL:

Archbishop Terrence Prendergast, S.J. will preside at a commemorative Mass in the Archbishop's Chapel near the Crypt, downstairs at Notre Dame Cathedral on Fri., June 5, 12:15 p.m. The Most Reverend J. Thomas Duhamel was the 2nd Bishop of Ottawa (1874-1886) and then the 1st Archbishop of Ottawa (1886-1909). All are welcome to attend this Mass.

2. ORDINATIONS TO THE DIACONATE: Archbishop Prendergast will ordain Louis Seward, James Kubina, and William Read to the Permanent Diaconate on Saturday, June 6, 10:00 a.m. at Notre Dame Cathedral. All are welcome.
