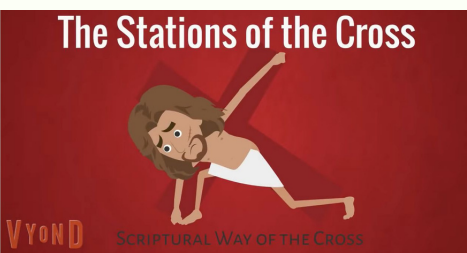
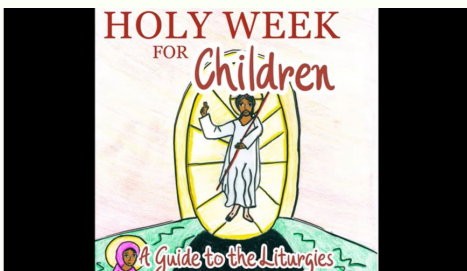

During Holy Week, which begins with Palm Sunday, we remember Jesus' final days. We remember His triumphant entry into Jerusalem, the Passover supper He shared with the apostles, His agony in the garden, His suffering and crucifixion.

This year we are permitted in our churches, at least to 30% capacity, but most of the normal gestures and symbols we associate with these important days will be missing. However, it is an opportunity to really dig into what matters, which is Jesus and what He did for us. We hope these links, crafts and videos help you and your children.
