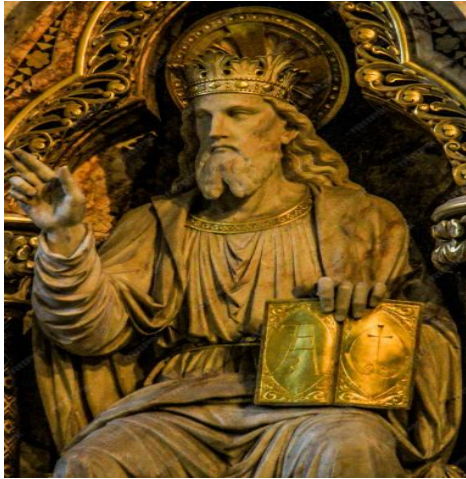

Pastor's Corner
Fourth Sunday In Ordinary Time - Reflection

Themes: humility, kingdom of God, heaven, wisdom

Chosen, Not Because We Are Strong, but Because We Trust

In today's Gospel (Matthew 5:1–12), Jesus proclaims the Beatitudes—a list that turns the world's values upside down. He calls blessed the poor in spirit, the meek, the merciful, and the peacemakers. These are not the people the world usually applauds, yet they are the ones closest to God's heart.

St Paul reminds us that God often chooses “what is weak in the world to shame the strong” (1 Corinthians 1:27). Like a small seed that looks insignificant but grows into a mighty tree, God's grace works powerfully in humble and trusting hearts.

The Beatitudes invite us to measure success not by power or possessions, but by love, faithfulness, and compassion. True happiness comes not from climbing over others, but from walking with Christ in simplicity and trust.

When we live the Beatitudes, we discover that God's strength shines brightest through our humility.

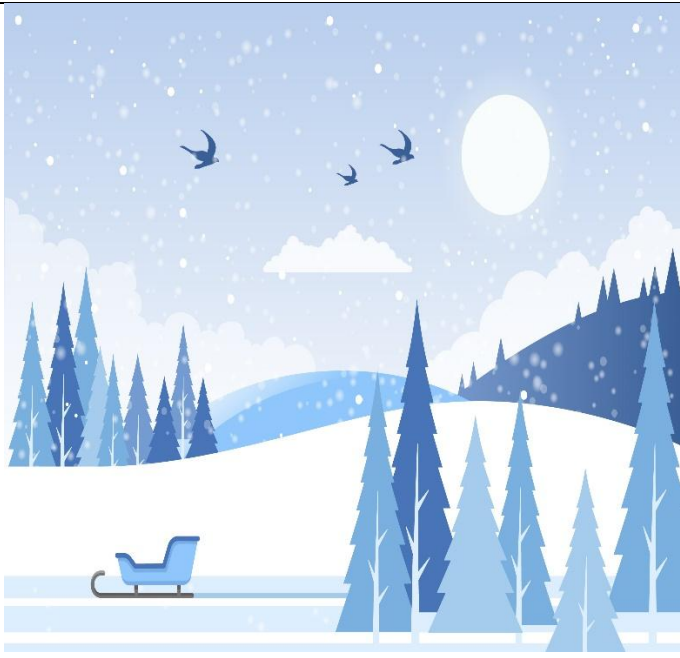

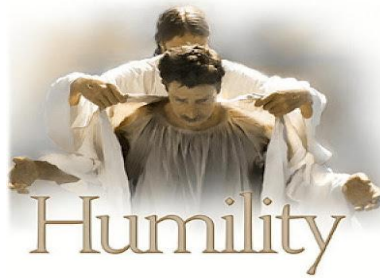
